

Beginning with students entering grade 9 in the 2015–16 school year, all courses shall be used to compute a student's grade point average (GPA). This includes dual enrollment courses and online courses under the supervision of District personnel. *We encourage you to review the GPA weighting chart below and consider the impact of course selection on GPA.*
