Additional Security Personnel



Adding 3 School Resource Officers (SRO)

In partnership with the Burleson Police Department as determined through ongoing evaluations, bringing the district total of SROs to 11.



Hiring School Safety Officers (SSO)

Professionals authorized to carry weapons who are responsible for providing and maintaining a safe and secure environment for students, staff, and visitors at all elementary campuses.



New Director of Safety & Security

Committed to heightened security through the implementation of enhanced security protocols, safety audits, and staff training.



New Director of Behavioral Threat Assessment & Intervention

Works directly with counselors and campus threat assessment teams to identify 'red flags' and intervene expeditiously.

BISD is adding:

- Multiple security personnel;
- Heightened district security protocols;
- Additional security measures for campus events; and
- Fidelity to security protocols in daily operations with uncompromising accountability.

BISD follows Texas School Safety Center (TxSSC) standards. Out of 1,022 districts, TxSSC identified BISD as:

- One of 67 districts statewide to have an emergency operations plan (EOP) that was deemed sufficient, meaning it met the best practices necessary to be a viable EOP; and
- One of 200 districts with a viable active shooter program.
